### 1. Zhongshan Underground Book Street

#### 4. Huo Shih Desserts

The simple white hut serves traditional shaved ice and other desserts, including the fresh peach flavored ice cream and candied tomatoes shaved ice, and the sweet and sour Strawberry Roselle shaved ice. Come and experience the delightful cool taste of summer.



### 5.Coffee Dumbo

Antique Taiwanese-style floor-to-ceiling decorative floral window railing and seats coupled with modern American furnishings, Coffee Dumbo attracts customers with its interior design and pastries such as the cinnamon rolls made of crispy brioche topped with caramel sauce and cinnamon powder.



### 6. Miss V Bakery

Renovated from an old house, this hipster coffee shop is famous for a wide variety of cinnamon rolls. All kinds of brunch meals, specialty drinks and the pastries are also popular with customers, attracting them to relax at the bakery the whole day.





### 13.SNAPPP AKA








#### Landmark Tour

#### 1. Tsai Jui-yueh Dance Research Institute

**Q** 10, Ln. 48, Sec. 2, Zhongshan N. Rd., Taipei City (02)2523-7547

This Japanese wooden building was once the residence and studio of Tsai Jui-yueh, a Taiwanese pioneer of modern dance. It now serves as an important educational base for nurturing young talent and a venue dedicated to dance performances.


