Beitou Park Outdoor Hot Spring Bathing Pool

Many people like to soak in the hot spring here in swimming suits. You only need to pay NT\$60 to enjoy the **outdoor hot spring**.



Even without a swimming suit, you can soak your feet in these 2 foot-soaking pools:

- **Fuxing Park**
- **Sulfur Valley**



After enjoying the hot spring, you can visit the exhibitions at the **Beitou Hot Spring Museum**.



You can join the guided tour to learn more about the museum.



Thermal Valley is also famous in Beitou. Surrounded by the smoke, it's like coming to a fairyland.



How to get to the Beitou Park Outdoor Hot Spring Bathing Pool?

Take the red line to MRT **R22** Beitou Station.

Transfer to MRT **R22A** Xinbeitou Station.

Walk for 7 minutes.

The Beitou Hot Spring Museum and the Thermal Valley are just close by.

You can ask the information center for directions.



Taipei Children's Amusement Park

Do you see the big white roof in the picture?

This is **Taipei Children's Amusement Park**.



Here, you can:



Ride on the
Ferris wheel.



Go to the theater to
watch a show.



Have fun high on the
Radial Flying Chairs.



If you are hungry,
just go to the **Shilin Night Market**.
There are a lot of yummy food there
and also beautiful clothes, shoes,
and toys.



How to get to Taipei Children's Amusement Park?

Take the red line to MRT **R16** Shilin Station.

Take **Exit 1** and walk for 20 minutes.

Or you can take the bus:

620, Red 30, or Taipei Children's Amusement Park Line 1.



How to get to Shilin Night Market?

Take the red line to MRT **R15** Jiantan Station.

Take **Exit 1** and walk for 6 minutes.

You can ask the information center for directions.



Taipei 101



Taipei 101 is the tallest building in Taiwan.

Sometimes, white clouds would even hug the top of Taipei 101!



Right by the side of Taipei 101, look around, see if you could find the **red “Love”** in the picture, a lot of people take a picture here.



The must-do here at Taipei 101 is to take the high-speed elevator to the **Observatory** on 89F to enjoy the view of Taipei City right beneath your feet.

On the night of December 31st, people would come together to celebrate the New Year! shouting out:
"5, 4, 3, 2, 1, Happy New Year!"
Then, we can see the beautiful firework of Taipei 101 and welcome the new year together.



How to get to Taipei 101?

You can take the red line to

MRT **R03** Taipei 101/World Trade Center Station.

Take **Exit 4**.

You can ask the information center for directions.



Ningxia Night Market



Ningxia Night Market offers various yummy food and drinks, like Egg Drop Meatball Soup and Crispy Taro Balls.

There are also games like shooting balloons and pinball.



Ningxia Night Market is the first no-smoking night market in Taiwan.

And cars are not allowed here.



How to get to Ningxia Night Market?

You could take the red line to MRT **R12** Shuanglian Station.

Take **Exit 1** and walk for 9 minutes.

You can ask the information center for directions.



The night market is not opened yet during the day.

You can go to **Dadaocheng Theater**.

There are exhibitions of Taiwanese glove puppetry.

You can also buy a ticket to watch a traditional play.

How to get to Dadaocheng Theater?

Take the green line to MRT **G13** Beimen Station.

Take **Exit 3** and walk for 8 minutes.



Dadaocheng Wharf

Dadaocheng Wharf is right beside the **Tamsui River**.

Long time ago, many people came here by boat to sell things.

Now you can take a ferry here
and enjoy the beautiful scenery along.



How to get to Dadaocheng Wharf?

Take the red line to
MRT **R13** Shuanglian Station.
Take **Exit 1** or **Exit 2**.
Walk for 15 minutes.





Walking down **Dihua Street**, you'll find lovely old houses there.



There is **Taipei Xia-Hai City God Temple**, where people come and pray, for the **Moon Elder** to find their soulmates.

The **Moon Elder** is an immortal, dedicated to matchmaking.



How to get to Taipei Xia-Hai City God Temple?

Walk for 8 minutes from **Exit 3** of MRT **G13** Beimen Station. You can ask the information center for directions.



Chiang Kai-shek Memorial Hall

Many people enjoy exercising or dancing here.



Do you see 2 grand houses
with a yellow roof?

One is the **National Theater Hall**.

The other is the **National Concert Hall**.

You can buy a ticket to a show here.



At the Chiang Kai-shek Memorial Hall, you can see the impressive **changing the guard ceremony** every hour on the hour every day.



The guard of honor is a very special army. By the color of their uniform, you can tell they belong to the Army, the Navy, or Air Force.

"Every hour on the hour" means:

9am, 10am, 11am, 12am, 1pm, 2pm, 3pm, 4pm, and 5pm.

How to get to Chiang Kai-shek Memorial Hall?

Take the green line or the red line to

MRT **G10** / **R08** Chiang Kai-shek Memorial Hall Station.

Take **Exit 5** and there you are.



Bangka Lungshan Temple



It is a very, very old temple.
Lots of people pray here.
They ask the gods for help.

Out of the respect for the gods,
remember to step inside from the
right side of the temple.
Raise your leg high,
and don't step on the threshold.



The **Herb Lane** is beside Bangka Lungshan Temple.

You can have a cup of cool Chinese herbal tea there!

How to get to Bangka Lungshan Temple?

Take the blue line to MRT **BL10** Longshan Temple Station.

Take **Exit 1** and walk for 3 minutes.



Huashan 1914 Creative Park



Do you see the high chimney?
Long ago, people made wine here.
Now it has become a place for exhibitions.



There are **4 adjoining houses**
in the Creative Park.
Larger scale exhibitions
will be held here.



There are markets and street performers.



There are also various featured shops, selling interesting gadgets, like toys made of wood.



How to get to Huashan 1914 Creative Park?

Take the blue line or the orange line to

MRT **BL14** / **O07** Zhongxiao Xincheng Station.

Take **Exit 1** and walk for 3 minutes.

You can ask the information center for directions.

Take **Exit 2** and walk for 5 minutes.



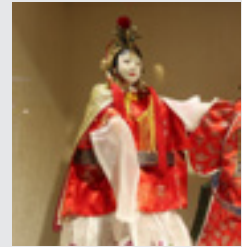
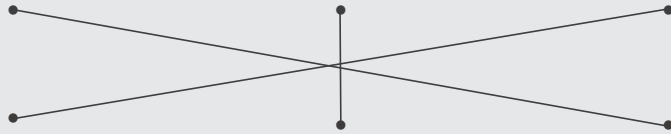
